**Schaller Anderson, Incorporated Named
One of Nation's Fastest-Growing Private Companies**

PHOENIX--Schaller Anderson, Incorporated, a company that manages health plans in seven states, has been named one of the top 500 fastest-growing companies in America by "Inc." magazine. This is the third year Schaller Anderson has been selected for the list.

"Inc." editors contacted independent, privately held businesses that had at least \$500,000 in net sales in the base year of 2001 and reviewed financial statements over three years. Rank is based on average annual sales growth.

"Surveying the landscape of the Inc. 500 is a little like reading a science-fiction novel," "Inc." staff wrote. "It's populated with both the familiar and with strange new concepts you've never considered...Thus far most of the private companies that have grown the fastest since 2001 have been flying under the radar of the mainstream business press."

Schaller Anderson experienced a 333 percent growth in revenues over the last five years, "Inc." said.

Incorporated 19 years ago, Schaller Anderson administers physical and behavioral health care for Medicaid, Medicare, commercial and employer self-funded health plans. Schaller Anderson's affiliated companies provide services in seven states—Arizona, California, Delaware, Maryland, Missouri, Tennessee and Texas—and serve more than 1.5 million people, managing \$2 billion in health care benefits with 1,500 employees.

Joe Anderson, Schaller Anderson chairman and CEO, said the company's selection by "Inc." was a result of "the commitment to service provided by the people in our company" and added that Schaller Anderson "has been able to attract and retain some of the best and the brightest people dedicated to service and improving health care outcomes."
